- This testing is on a **first-come, first-serve basis**. Registration will close when all slots are filled.

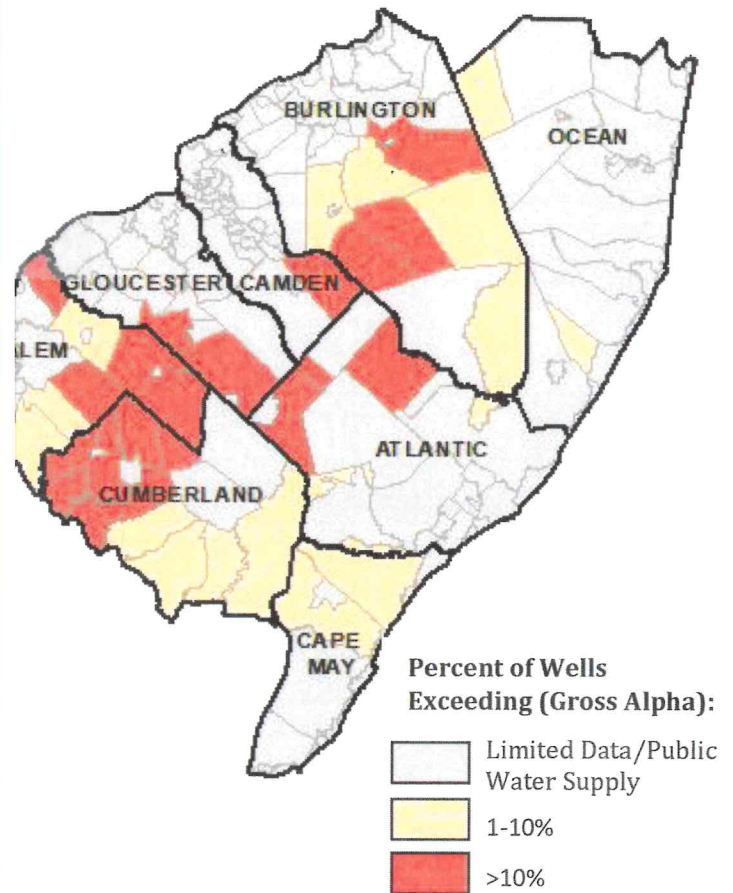
